Do not put a box on the page to show the size of your booklet page Instead, include crop marks on all four corners to show us where to cut your printed pages. Crop marks are only necessary if the printing on your pages bleeds to the edge of the sheet.

The blue line marks the "safe area". It is .375 " inside the spine edge of your printed piece and .25 " from the other 3 sides. Keep any wording or important parts of your artwork within this area to prevent it from being trimmed

The spine is opposite on the even pages when printing double sided.

The grey area is the size of your printed page after your booklet has been trimmed.
This sample document is setup as an $8.5 \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ booklet.
You may choose to print any sized booklet within reason, but please follow the guidelines in this example for page size, crop, bleed, safe area, and booklet layout.
